Contents and summary of discussions:

Bennington Veterans Incubator Farm Cooperative

Mr. Fernandez, Ms. Barsotti and Ms. Sgorbati joined our meeting to discuss the Bennington Veterans Incubator Farm Cooperative. This Cooperative is to develop and utilize funds from the Bennington Fair Food Initiative effectively through strategic leveraging of funds and aims to enhance sustainable veteran agriculture with minimal programmatic burden and liability concerns for the VVH. The goals are to create a connected farm and food system, boost the growth of the agricultural workforce, establish farm-to-institution partnerships, acting as a hub for marketing and aggregation of cooperative members' products. This project was approved by the Trustees to move forward at our June 2024 meeting. We discussed the leasing of approximately 20 acres and reviewed the map of the Bennington Veterans Home property; where land is already leased or reserved for the home and what is available. We reviewed the different types of Plans: Forrest Management, Soil Health Management, Grazing Management, and Irrigation Water Management. Water and electrical usage was discussed and there are options available that would not impact the water supply or electrical usage of the home. A lease agreement will be brought to the Board of Trustees' meeting in August for Board approval.
