Positive Unit Visitor Guidelines

December 28, 2021

- 1. All visitors must pass the usual COVID screening process.
- 2. Facial coverings are to be worn at all times regardless of vaccination status and location.
- 3. Frequent hand hygiene using alcohol-based hand sanitizer is recommended
- 4. Visits must take place in the Veteran's/Member's room or outside.
- 5. Visitors are prohibited from entering common areas such as dining rooms, activity rooms and congregating by the nurse's station.
- 6. Eating and drinking during a visit should be avoided.
- 7. Maintain social distancing for the duration of your visit.
